

## Ideum Releases New Ultra Thin 55" Multitouch Table

CORRALES, New Mexico (July 18, 2011) Ideum has announced the release of new 55" high-definition multitouch table. Called *The Platform*, the table has the thinnest top of any commercially available multitouch tables. It is a mere 3 inches thick.

*The Platform* is the second in a series of 55" HD LCD multitouch tables Ideum has released; it blends strength, high performance and exceptional design with its exceedingly thin profile. The table is made from aircraft-grade aluminum and has a powerful and fully integrated solid-state computer system. The interactive 55-inch LCD screen has 32-touch point and 3 inches thick. Like all MT55 series tables, it has single-button operation. Just plug it in and turn it on.

The bright 55" 1920×1080 HD display has a 5,000,000:1 contrast ratio. A wide 178-degree viewing angle accommodates multiple users around the table. The optical multitouch system supports 32 simultaneous touch points for collaborative interaction. The LCD has an LED backlight and is rated for 50,000 hours.

The screen is protected by haptic, non-reflective 5mm tempered glass called *HapticGlas*. Made by European glassmaker *Sevasa*, it provides tactile feedback, reduces fingerprints, and increases scratch resistance. This is the first time that this new glass has been made available in any product.

*The Platform* has a powerful integrated computer. The CPU is an Intel® Hyper-Threaded DualCore i5 @ which runs at 2.66GHz. It has 8GB of RAM, 128GB solid-state hard drive. Purchasers can also choose an optional i7 and 256GB solid-state hard drive.

The revolutionary MT55 *Platform* design makes the table easily accessible from all directions. The entire unit stands 31" tall, matching ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) requirements.

"This form factor really pushes multitouch table design. It's so thin, but it doesn't compromise strength or performance," said Jim Spadaccini, Director of Ideum. "We wanted to do something more than just add four legs to a screen. We wanted to create a functional design that is also beautiful."

*The Platform* is multitouch-enabled from start up and runs Windows 7 Professional 64-bit. The integrated multitouch table comes complete with full two-year warranty.

The table has tons of ways to connect. It comes complete with WIFI, Bluetooth, and Ethernet capability. It also has HDMI output to allow you to easily mirror the table's display. Ethernet (CAT5), HDMI input (to display a second source), and multiple USB 2.0 ports are included.

The MT55 *Platform* ships with GestureWorks for Adobe Flash. With support for more than 200 gestures, GestureWorks is the most advanced multitouch SDK available. The package includes nearly a dozen pre-built Open Exhibits multitouch components.
